The Bosnia and Herzegovina has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Air Quality Improvement Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for *Procurement of equipment for strengthening of the AQ monitoring and inversion layer characteristics in Canton Sarajevo for the needs of the Ministry of Communal Economy, Infrastructure, Physical Planning, Construction and Environmental Protection of Sarajevo Canton*.
2. The Federal Ministry of Environment and Tourism now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for *Procurement of equipment for strengthening of the AQ monitoring and inversion layer characteristics in Canton Sarajevo for the needs of the Ministry of Communal Economy, Infrastructure, Physical Planning, Construction and Environmental Protection of Sarajevo Canton*.

Location of delivery and installation is Bosnia and Herzegovina - Sarajevo, period of delivery and installation is 6 months.

3. Bidding will be conducted through national competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" November 2020 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

5. The bidding document in English language will be provided in electronic copy to all interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below. Interested Bidders are requested to provide the following details under application: full name of the company, address, contact details (phone number, and email address). The document will be sent by via an email.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 14th October 2026, 10:00 hrs local time. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 14th October 2026, 10:30 hrs local time
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security for contracts as follows: 6.000,00 BAM.
